This in+care Campaign, sponsored by the HRSA HIV/AIDS Bureau through collaboration with the National Quality Center (NQC), is designed to facilitate local, regional, and State-level efforts while building and sustaining a learning community among Ryan White grantees and their subproviders.

This national quality improvement initiative will focus on retaining patients in HIV care and preventing patients from falling out of care. This topic has been identified as a critical challenge for HIV providers across the country and aligns with local and regional HIV policies as well as the National HIV/AIDS Strategy.

The Campaign has the potential to impact a significant number of people living with HIV/AIDS across the country receiving Ryan White HIV/AIDS services, and to improve their overall health outcomes.

Leading clinical experts and researchers, quality improvement professionals, key stakeholders, and recipients of Ryan White will all be involved.

Participation in the Campaign is voluntary and Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program grantees across all funding streams and their subproviders are invited to join.

Expectations for Participation

- participating Ryan White providers enroll for a 12-month commitment
- reporting up to 4 uniform campaign-related measures via an online database every other month
- implementation of improvement activities to retain patients in HIV care and prevent patients from falling out of HIV care
- routine sharing of updates to highlight improvement strategies and challenges
- participation in monthly conference calls/webinars to provide content expertise and promote peer sharing and learning
- where possible, join regional/local face-to-face meetings of peer campaign participants.

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
